



# SIGHT WORD TIC TAC TOE

*Fluency is the ability to read text quickly, accurately and with proper expression.*

## Materials:

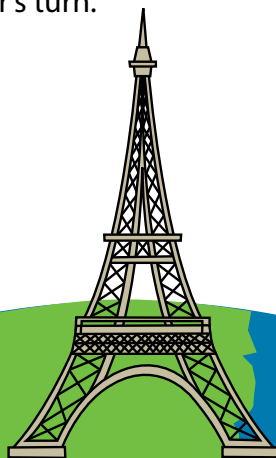
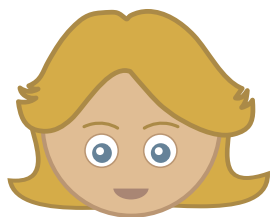
- Tic-tac-toe boards (provided)
- Lists of sight words (provided)
- Markers

## Preparation:

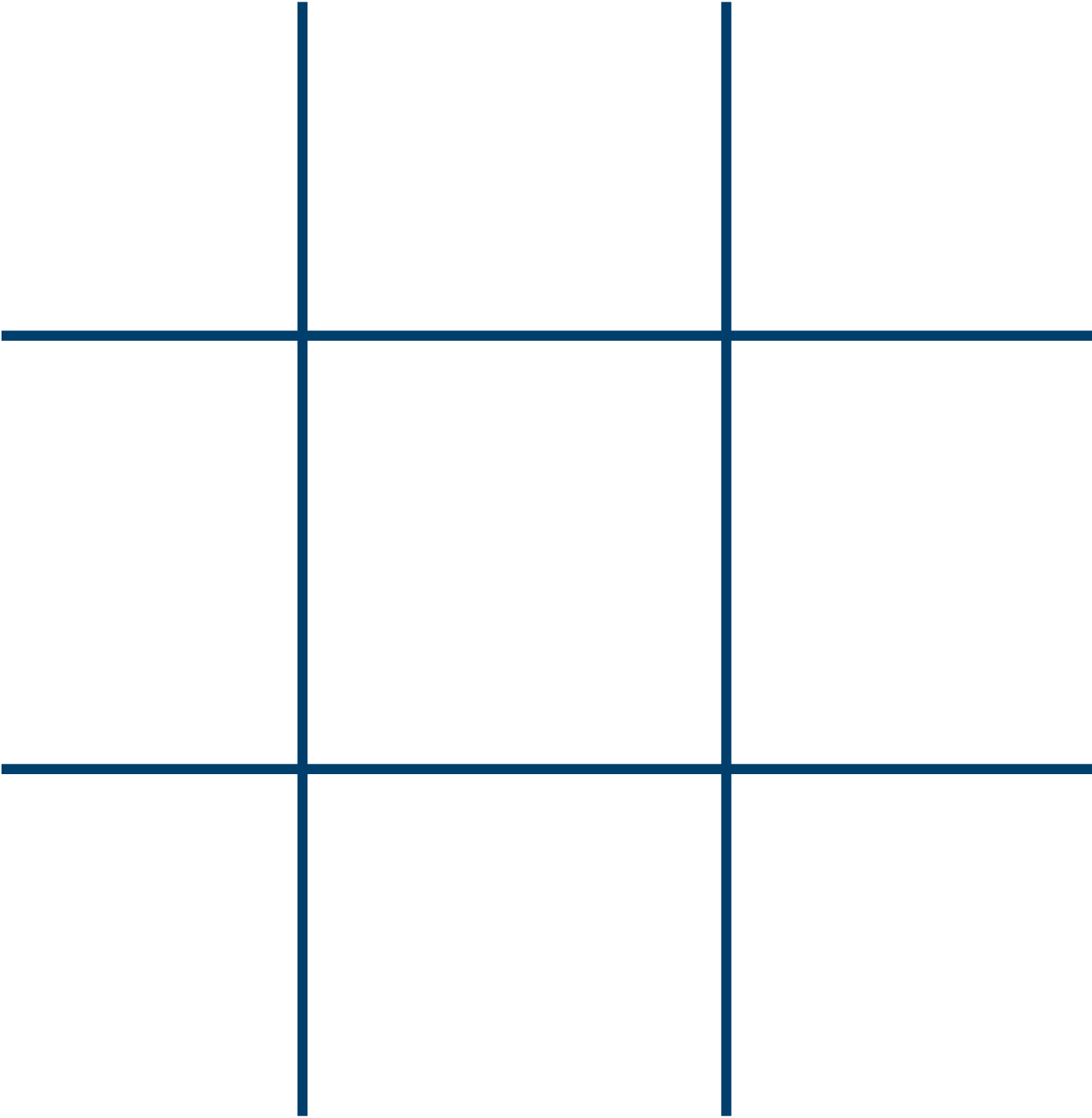
- Print the tic-tac-toe board and lists of sight words.
- Make enough copies for all participating families to get one of each.

## Activity Instructions:

1. Hand out tic-tac-toe boards to pairs of parents and children.
2. Ask **parents** to write one sight word from the appropriate grade-level list on each square of their board.
3. **Invite families to play tic-tac-toe together**, with this variation:
  - a. To mark the board, players must first read the word in the square they want to occupy.
  - b. Once the word has been read correctly, players may mark the square with either an X or an O, and it is the next player's turn.
