

Proposed Bylaws Amendment: NLRC Resignation (Article VIII—Elections and Appointments, Section 2. Officers and Board Members. A.3 Eligibility)

**Article VIII—Elections and Appointments, Section 2. Officers and Board Members. A.3 Eligibility**

Proposed Amendment: To amend Article VIII—Elections and Appointments, Section 2 A.3 Eligibility, by inserting the words “**or to the nominating and leadership recruitment committee**” as follows:

A current state constituent association president elected to the National PTA Board of Directors **or to the nominating and leadership recruitment committee** shall resign the state presidency within fourteen (14) days from the close of the convention of which they were elected.

**Current Version**

A current state constituent association president elected to the National PTA Board of Directors shall resign the state presidency within fourteen (14) days from the close of the convention of which they were elected.

**Proposed Version**

A current state constituent association president elected to the National PTA Board of Directors or to the Nominating and Leadership Recruitment Committee shall resign the state presidency within fourteen (14) days from the close of the convention of which they were elected.

**Rationale:** For consistency purposes the board of director members are elected as well as the Nominating and Leadership Recruitment Committee (NLRC). They are both part of NPTA Governance. This will prevent a conflict of interest while serving on this committee whose main goal is to vet and search for National PTA leadership and governance.
