<p>Welcome by PTA leader or Principal</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> This may also be a good time to introduce any special guest speakers and allow them to give opening remarks 	(5 minutes)
<p>Student Panel:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> PTSA student leader(s) from local high school or college could share their advice/lessons learned about social media to younger students. Use the student panel prompts and select a moderator that makes sense for your school. This is a great opportunity to partner with your principle, librarian or a technology teacher. 	(15 minutes)
<p>Online Scenario Skit Activity:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use the slide deck to introduce families to Tik Tok and the privacy settings that they can use. (5 minutes) Share the pre-selected online scenario (or multiple online scenarios depending on event size) with families. Ask them to break into groups and design a 15 second skit of the best way to react if the scenario was to happen to them. (10 minutes) Bring the group back together and select 2 – 3 groups to share their skit. Use the #XX to join in on the Safer Internet Day challenge 	(20 minutes)
<p>Sharing other digital safety resources:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use the slide deck to introduce families to PTA Connected, Connect Safely and The Smart Talk. PTA Leader who has completed The Smart Talk with their family can share testimonial of their experience (National PTA talking points can serve as starting point) 	(5 minutes)
<p>Audience Q&A</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Allow time for some discussion and answer any attendee questions. Ensure all attendees have received fliers and have shared follow-up contact information if applicable 	(10 minutes)
